Day 4 (18 November)

Acoustic sensor was lowered for almost 2 hours. During this period, we had lunch and played cards. A porpoise was also discovered by the boatman when we were playing cards. There is a sandy island near our site, where many birds are resting there. I can't identify the bird but when they flied together, the scene was really impressive. After getting back the sensor, we went back to Hukou. As I'm so sleepy, I slept for almost an hour. I don't know why, when I was sleeping, the dog always barked at me. But anyway, I slept very well.

Wei said there should be a lot of porpoises there before. But now, it's hardly to see them. The outdoor temperature is about 5 degree Celsius. How tough are we?? Haha.
